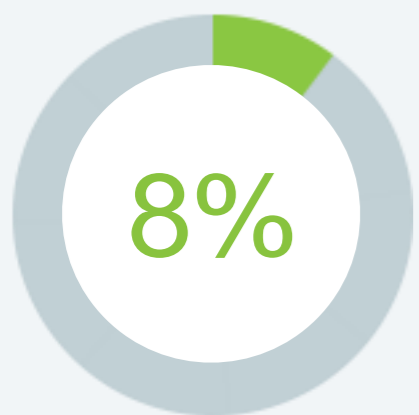


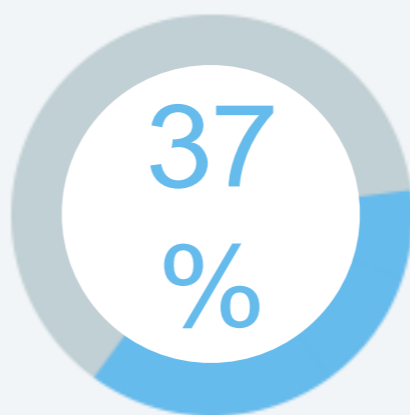

6 Student Sustainability Champs

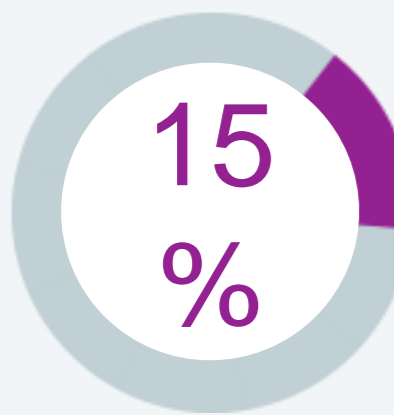

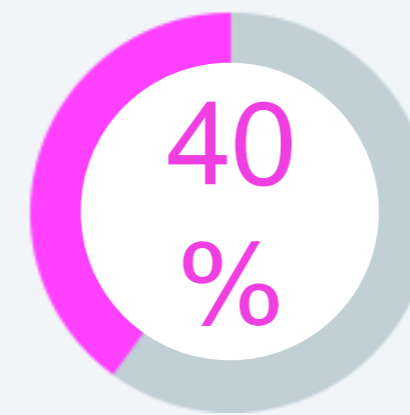

8 Enterprise Champs

Enterprise Champs (eChamps) work in partnership with staff and students in the faculties, mentored by staff in Career Destinations, Research and Innovation Services, and other Enterprise stakeholders at the University and trained via the Government's IPO. The Enterprise Champs will help develop coherent communications, resources and workshops, around Enterprise and IP, focused on the various disciplinary and sector perspectives.
