- **Eighteen months** duration (Sept 2014 Mar 2016)
- Motivated by the desire to create a more inclusive and relevant international culture at the University
- It builds on the work done by the University of Southampton Internationalisation Forum (USIF)
- Extends the work of this group to students and the local community
- Focuses on cultural exchange inside and outside the classroom in the broader context of internationalisation practice and policy at the University
