- ➤ Online course: *optional*, *not tutored*, *not assessed*, focusing on student preparation and acculturation pre-arrival
- ➤ Content focus: practical aspects of living in Britain + preparation for the University of Southampton + taste of UK academic culture and study skills
- Open for 5 months but study pace and length of use decided by individual student
- ➤ Self-access interactive learning content with feedback (activity-based Learning Objects) and *Open Content videos and student blogs*
- Community-building/personal contact through Social Wall; student-led Conversation Forum; social networks



### Objectives of the online course

- ➤ To learn a bit about the city of Southampton and surroundings
- > To find out about everyday life at a university as a student
- ➤ To provide a taste of UK academic culture and what might they expect when they begin their studies
- > To make contact and friends, and communicate with other students
- > To develop confidence; allay concerns and fears

### Evolution: from small scale to large scale

- ➤ 2005 -2006: closed tutored groups of 25; fixed time slots; learning from content designed as interactive learning objects and tutor-led discussion in forums.
- ➤ 2007 -2010: growth in group size (c. 80); podcast and video content informal audio tutor scaffolding and guidance; chat sessions.
- ➤ 2010-2014: 2500+ students; Web 2.0 Open Content (student-centred videos; student blogs) social wall; quiz; student-led forums; untutored.

I found it very useful and reassuring and [it] gives me self-confidence and sense of ease. (student, 2011 course)



### Intercultural connections

- ➤ Challenges with YouTube, Facebook etc global accessibility; different social networking preferences
- Last year interactions among 136 different nationalities both on- and off-course
- ➤ Links to UoS student clubs and societies offer potential for contact with home students
- Moving from small to large scale and closed to more open model has made it difficult to know how much activity is going on off-course but student reports are v. positive.
