Usability survey

This is a **brief** survey (300 words as a guide) which the critical friends will complete in order to help us evaluate the leapin.it app.

There are 3 parts to the survey: interface comparison, general interface evaluation, concept evaluation.

Information you will need:

Two different interfaces are available below (more will be explained below):

Honeycomb: http://leapin.it/?honeycomb

Use them on you desktop computer. You could try them on your mobile, but it's currently only been tested on android.

You will be provided with accounts.

Notes:

- the test user is already resident of some rooms, and has made a few posts
- It is possible to add photos and text, but not videos
- To create a room, just enter a random code on the scan screen (orange button).
- Profile pages, avatars and friendships are not yet working
- There's a bug where, if you are logged in and refresh, you must start typing in the login box to be logged back in
- After some actions (adding post, leaving room), the page needs to be refreshed

Interface comparison

Two interfaces have been created for displaying posts. The first - "standard" - is a linear list of posts ordered by time, similar to the facebook newsfeed. The second - "Honeycomb" - is a hexagonal grid of posts, which will position posts based on relevance and time.

We need a critique and comparison of the two interfaces (links above). In particular, think about the following:

- the effectiveness of both interfaces at displaying...
 - an overview of recent activity
 - o an overview of a room
 - o an overview of the individual post (i.e. does it tell you enough about the post itself)

- is it self-explanatory?
 - we may wish to include a "walkthrough" when a user first logs in suggestions on what should go here would be great
- merits of each interface
- any problems you foresee with either interface, suggestions

General interface evaluation

Use the honeycomb interface. Ignoring the style in which posts are displayed (Honeycomb or standard), comment on the following

- how easy the interface is to use
- it's appropriateness as a mobile app
- the visual appeal (does it look good, is it appropriately designed)
- is it self-explanatory? suggestions for the walkthrough?

Concept evaluation

Use the honeycomb interface. This is less about the app interface itself, and more about the idea of leapin.it. Comment on the following:

- is this a tool you would use? how would you use it? does the app facilitate that?
- pro's / con's of using barcodes/qr-codes?
- any other comments
